There is a moderate paced ride each week

of about 25 miles (M), average 10-12 mph. On the first Saturday of each month there will be an additional faster-paced ride (F) which hopefully will accommodate the varying cycling speeds of the riders who come out. Both rides will be led and will leave at the same time from Alton Community Centre, unless otherwise stated, so at the start you can decide which ride to go on.

Rides start from the Butts (AB) unless otherwise stated. Two rides, a mid paced (13 - 15 mph), marked (M) and a faster (16+ mph), marked (F) leave the Butts at 9:00am and usually have the same coffee and pub lunch stops. Off-road riding is more demanding than road riding. Stamina-wise assume each mile off-road is very roughly equivalent to two on-road; even more if it's very muddy. Some routes are more technical (narrow single-track, very rocky, steep ups or downs, steps etc) than others. Some rides are explicitly declared as "not suitable for beginners". Other rides are explicitly

declared as "beginners welcome": these are particularly suitable to riders who have not ridden with us before to help you gauge and improve your stamina and bike control and to give you a feel of our benchmarks.
